

WHAT WE DO

Home visitation on a person to person basis is the cornerstone of our work and around 2,500 home, hospital and prison visits are carried out weekly.

Our 1,900 volunteers work within all communities visiting the elderly, families and individuals offering spiritual, financial and material help for things such as food, clothing, furniture, electrical items, fuel and holidays.

Each year around £3m of your money is spent on these activities.

In addition to the visitation programme the Society is involved in a wide range of other activities, including:-

- Clothing and Furniture Shops
- Home Management Courses
- Holiday Home
- Crèches
- Breakfast and Afterschool Clubs
- Drop in Centres
- Furniture Collections

The Society is involved in Twinning with Ghana, helping refugees and providing education grants,

About Gift Aid

To qualify for Gift Aid and reclaim tax relief, what you pay in income tax or capital gains tax must at least equal the amount we will claim in the tax year.

If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, contact your local tax office.

If your declaration covers donations you may make in the future, please notify the Society of St Vincent de Paul if you change your name or address while the declaration is still in force.

You can cancel the declaration at any time by notifying us in writing.

Benefits to higher-rate tax payers

If you pay tax at 40%, you can reclaim tax relief on the grossed up amount of your donation. For example: if you give £100 we can claim an extra £25 and you can reclaim another £20.

What happens next?

We will acknowledge receipt of your signed form by posting you back a copy. So long as you do not cancel within 30 days the Gift Aid agreement will commence.
